Frequently Asked Questions

Who makes up the Camp Staff?

Our camp is staffed with a director, administrator, program coordinator, nurse and food service director. In addition, each classroom has a certified teacher/mentor, college mentor and high school student assistant. Most of our college staff are working towards a degree in education.

All staff are screened through reference checks including child abuse clearances, criminal background checks (if over 18) and attend special orientation sessions that include basic first aid procedures, child abuse prevention and recognition, program planning, age appropriate activities, and character development awareness. We place a high value on each member of our staff being a good role model.

What is included in each week's schedule?

Each day includes breakfast, lunch, morning meeting with counselors, small group times for academic enrichment, recreation time, and group activities such as games, skits, crafts and more. In addition, campers swim twice a week, meet special guests, participate in special events and go on a full day field trip once per week. The summer also provides small trip opportunities such as skating, summer stage, Mann Music Center performances and MORE!

What are the expectations regarding behavior?

We expect that everyone, children and staff alike, relate to each other acording to values that reflect respect, honesty and responsibility, and in ways that communicate dignity and concern for others. Rules and behavior guidelines will be provided in the parent handbook as well as a basic rules agreement to be signed by parents and campers.

When are my camp fees due?

A non-refundable \$50 registration fee is due when submitting your child's application. Weekly fees are due the Wednesday BEFORE each week that you child attends. So the first payment is due before camp begins... Then Wednesday of week1 the payment for week2 will be due and so on...
